Children and Youth Ministries

During our 8:30 and 11:15 traditional services, the children are included in the service with a special message at the front of the church. Afterwards, children ages 4-7 who may not be ready to sit through an entire worship service, may go to Children's Church. Details and sign up are located in the lobby before worship services.

Nursery

Paid staff care for infants through 3-year-olds during all worship services. We have an infant room and a toddler room.

Sunday School

Classes are open to all (potty-trained) children three-years-old to high school. All children move into



the age/grade-appropriate classroom on Promotion Sunday at the end of August.

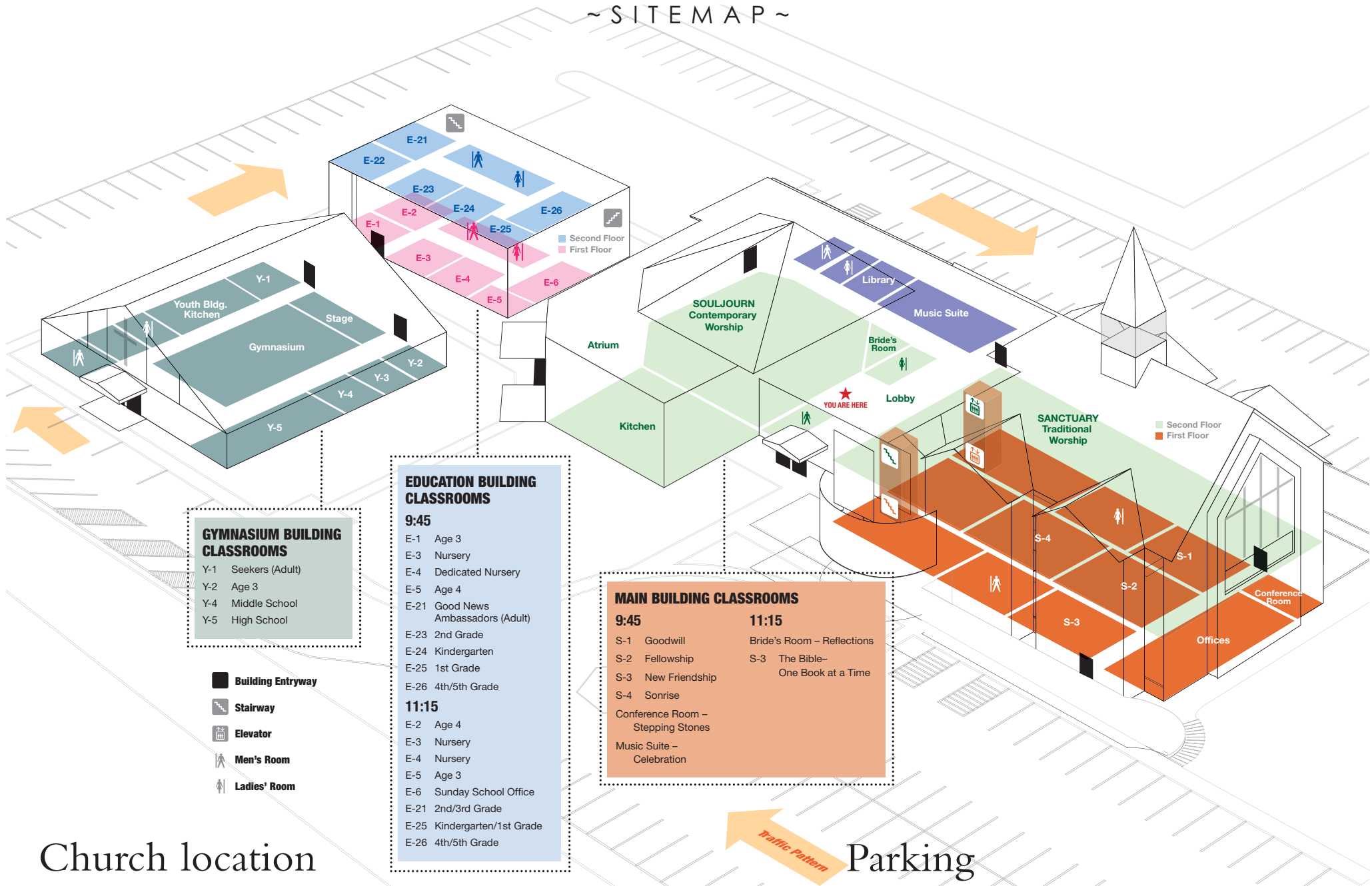
